We continue to monitor COVID-19 updates and follow recommendations and guidelines from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the Pennsylvania Department of Health, and the Governor of Pennsylvania.

We are still reporting to the PA Department of Health and the CDC.
