- Participates in weekly Interdisciplinary Group (IDG) meetings.
- Identifies need for and coordinates appropriate patient and family centered health teaching.
- Appropriately delegates tasks to Hospice Aides and LPN/LVN.
- Supervises the Hospice Aide and LPN/LVN at routine intervals.
- Actively participates in the Agency's Quality Assurance and Process Improvement (QAPI) Program.
- Seeks out opportunities for personal and professional growth through continuing education programs, in-services and conferences.
- Is able to work effectively as a part of a team and independently with minimal supervision.
- Possesses strong written and verbal communication skills.
